10. Vendors must remain until 3:00 PM with booths intact. FOR YOUR SAFETY AND THAT OF OUR GUESTS YOU ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BRING VEHICLES INTO THE AREA UNTIL YOU ARE NOTIFIED BY YOUR COURT SUPERVISORS.

Application deadline is April 30, 2011; "Swan Dollar" deadline is April 1, 2011.

Review, sign and return Hold Harmless Agreement with your application and fee.

No exhibitor may use the Swan Festival name or the Swan Festival logo without the prior approval of the Swan Festival Committee.

Exhibitors will not be allowed to nail, screw, or otherwise attach anything to, trees, doors, pavement, etc.

All trash must be placed in the nearest trash container.

No alcoholic beverages or drugs will be permitted.

All exhibitors must be open at all times stated in the Registration Form and listed above for Inspections.

The Swan Festival Committee and any local governing agency, reserves the right to remove anyone not complying with these rules. No refund will be given to exhibitors requested to leave due to their non-compliance.
